8. GOD WHO WE CANNOT SEE

God reveals Himself to man

A non-believer may question, "Why do you believe in God that you cannot see?" He seems to imply that anything that cannot be seen does not exist and is therefore unbelievable. The question is, is this assertion true?

It is like a little fish that swims freely in a big ocean but is unaware of it. It knows it is surrounded by water, but it does not know that the surrounding water is part of the vast ocean. We are surrounded by air, and there is oxygen in the air which we depend on to live. However, we are often not consciously aware of our dependency on oxygen.
